On 25 February 2021, The Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code was amended to introduce new requirements for labelling of allergens.

From 28 January 2021, kangaroo can be harvested in Victoria for human consumption, provided it is processed at PrimeSafe licensed game meat processing facility.

## PrimeSafe Licences and Information are Online

PrimeSafe licences are moving online, with PrimeSafe launching an online Licence Portal. PrimeSafe will initially concentrate on supporting the licensees who need to renew their licences before 30 June 2021, to ensure they can start using the PrimeSafe Licence Portal at this renewal.

#### Reminder for Licence Renewals

The following licence categories are required to be renewed before 30 June 2021:

- · Meat Transport Vehicle
- Abattoir
- · Further Meat Processing Facility
- · Poultry Processing Facility
- · Prime Tallow Processing Facility
- · Inedible Rendering Facility
- · Pet Meat Processing Facility
- · Pet Food Establishment
- Meat Inspectors

Note: This year Meat Transport Vehicles **must** be inspected at designated locations (not at the PrimeSafe office).
